

Tombstone Inscriptions Town of Dunkirk Cemetery

This cemetery might be described as the northwesternmost section of the present combined cemetery located east of Bennett Rd. and north of Williams Street, Dunkirk, NY. It is presently cared for and maintained as part of St. Mary's Cemetery.

The gravestone inscriptions were read in the fall of 1990. We attempted to reconcile our reading with the names on the old map which was copied from the brown paper original in 1974 by F. C. Buckries and placed in the Dunkirk Historical Museum. We were not always successful. We also found that the rows were not as well defined as we might like. The map (reduced from the 24" x 24" copy), has been included on page 17 minus only the easternmost row of unnamed graves and the magnetic north directional arrow.

We commenced this work at the corner of Bennett Road and the drive separating this old Town of Dunkirk cemetery and the old section of St. Mary's Catholic Church cemetery. We have listed each row starting at the drive and walking north (parallel) with Bennett Road (Rt 60). The rows have been given arbitrary, ascending numbers counting West to East. The earliest burial we were able to identify was Louise P. Newman, 16 April 1864 which was incidently the first stone we read.
