Walked from Erie PA to Dunkirk in eleven hours and forty three minutes....won wager of \$280 that he could not accomplish it in twelve hours...He was generously entertained by his Dunkirk friends.
- GEORGE Isaac (Rev) X 22 Nov 1867 Dunkirk 22 Nov 1867  
Donation visit at Armory Hall. He is going West for venefit of his wife's health and is compelled to resign his pastorage here. All are invited. Dunkirk Cornet Band will be present to enliven the occcasion.
- SMITH Joshua R M 15 Nov 1867 Dunkirk 22 Nov 1867  
Arrived at Erie Hotel with Miss Sarah Crocker, both from Buffalo, claiming to be married and planned to proceed on West. Two officers showed up with father of Miss Crocker. They had been living together as man and wife for two years and Judge Danie cocluded that was long enough to be married. The father insisted a ceremony be performed then and there or Mr Smith taken to lockup. A minister was called and a quiet wedding performed at 2 am.

son of Dr Merrill E Shaw, of Buffalo, formerly of Sinclairville, was among the killed in a recent massacre by the Indians on the overland route.

aged 43 years....3 Jan 1868: Born in Aberdeen, Scotland...came to US 1855, located in Buffalo. For past four years employed in Boiler Dept of Erie Railway Co, located in Dunkirk.

of consumption, aged 40 years, 3 mos.
