Ms. Lis: Basically it's a pretty simple resolution we have here. HEAP is a program that hits us at the beginning of the year because we are paying now for last winter. When I put the budget together, we had seen a couple of years where we were spending less so we decreased our budget in HEAP but now we're back up kind of to where we have been. You just never know who you are going to get and of course last winter was probably tough on people. So we need to add some to that budget and I'm taking it out of our State training school budget because we are looking pretty good there. We had budgeted for 4 kids to be there for the entire year. One of them has gone into after care which is free. We haven't added any kids and now we're getting half way through the year so I feel like probably \$30,000 is a drop in bucket over there. So I took the funding from that to cover for HEAP.

Mrs. Dennison: I just noticed a couple of typos. I don't know why we didn't catch these the first time around but just a formatting thing. Under the increase appropriation and decrease appropriation there are a couple of periods missing. So under the increase appropriation, it should read A.6141.---.4 and then the same thing under the decrease appropriation A.6129.---.4.
