LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY NO. 3-22 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

AMENDING LOCAL LAW 7-90 PROVIDING FOR A MANAGEMENT SALARY PLAN FOR COUNTY OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES (Re: PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT COORDINATOR)

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Additional Title.

The Chautauqua County Management Salary Plan, as set forth in Local Law 7-90, and as amended, is hereby further amended to add the new title of Personnel Development Coordinator.

Section 2. <u>Salary Level.</u>

The title of Personnel Development Coordinator shall be placed in Range 3 (\$46,873 - \$71,747) of the 2022 Management Salary Plan.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
