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This collection was transcribed from a card file kept over the years by Virginia Washburn Barden, Co-Historian for the Town of Ripley, Chautauqua County, New York. Many of these records concern that northwestern section of the county where Ripley is located, but bits of history turn up here relevant to many people throughout Chautauqua County and its surrounding areas in Pennsylvania, Canada and other counties in New York State. Most of her cards noted the original source. The newspaper sources are underlined and the cited newspapers are on microfilm at Patterson Library in Westfield.
