### LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY NO. 11-22 CHAUTAUQUA COUNTY

#### A LOCAL LAW CONTINUING AN ADDITIONAL MORTGAGE TAX

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York, as follows:

- 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Local Law is to continue without interruption the additional mortgage tax previously imposed and continued pursuant to Local Laws 6-05, 8-08, 3-11, 4-14, 1-17, and 7-19 of the County of Chautauqua.
- 2. Additional Mortgage Tax. Pursuant to Section 253-o of New York State Tax Law and other applicable law, there is hereby continued an additional tax of twenty-five cents for each one hundred dollars and each remaining major fraction thereof of principal debt or obligation which is or under any contingency may be secured at the date of execution thereof, or at any time thereafter, by a mortgage on real property situated within the County of Chautauqua and recorded on or after the date upon which such tax takes effect and a tax of twenty-five cents on such mortgage if the principal debt or obligation which is or by any contingency may be, secured by such mortgage is less than one hundred dollars.
- 3. <u>Administration, Collection, and Payment of Additional Mortgage Tax</u>. The additional mortgage tax continued pursuant to this Local Law shall be administered, collected, and paid over to the County of Chautauqua in the manner provided in Section 253-o of New York State Tax Law and other applicable law.
- 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. This local law shall take effect November 1, 2022, and applies to the period beginning November 1, 2022, and continuing through, and including, July 31, 2025. A certified copy of this local law shall be mailed by certified mail to the New York State Commissioner of Taxation and Finance, and shall be filed with the County Clerk, the Secretary of State, and the Office of State Comptroller.

WHEREAS, the Chautauqua County Legislature adopted Resolution 184-22 calling a public hearing pursuant to County Law §268 for the purpose of considering a project to reduce Infiltration and Inflow (I & I) in the collection system of the Portland, Pomfret, Dunkirk Sewer District (PPDSD); and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was duly published and mailed as required by law and the public hearing was held at the Legislative Chambers, Gerace Office Building, Mayville, New York on August 24, 2022 at 6:35 PM, prevailing time; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has duly considered the July 2022 Map and Plan report prepared by Barton & Loguidice, engineers duly licensed in the state of New York, as well as the testimony and other information received by it at the public hearing and otherwise; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, upon the Map and Plan report and other data filed with it, the Legislature hereby determines in accordance with County Law §268 that it is in the public interest to construct the proposed improvements for the reduction of I & I as described in the Map and Plan report and in the Notice of Public Hearing for a maximum amount to be expended of \$1,612,000.00 (the Project), and the Project is approved; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the initial allocation of the costs of the improvements as between the zones of assessment as described in the Map and Plan report and in the Notice of Public Hearing are hereby approved, with each of the three PPDSD zones of assessment bearing the expense of the improvements in accordance with the benefit received, and with

Charge Area A1, the sewer system formerly owned by the Van Buren Point Association, Inc. available prior to 1984, bearing a maximum estimated annual cost of \$161.19, which when added to the estimated average annual sewer charge will be expected to result in a maximum annual sewer charge of \$755.78;

Charge Area A2, the sewer system formerly owned by the Shore Acres Association, Inc. available prior to 1984, bearing a maximum estimated annual cost of \$267.59, which when added to the estimated average annual sewer charge will be expected to result in a maximum annual sewer charge of \$1,120.13; and

Charge Area B, property served by a collection system which was constructed by the PPDSD, bearing a maximum estimated annual cost of \$17.34, which when added to the estimated average annual sewer charge will be expected to result in a maximum annual sewer charge of \$786.16; and be it further

RESOLVED, That to the extent that the cost of the improvements and the expense of operation and maintenance are not paid from the revenues of the PPDSD, they shall be assessed in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefit which each lot or parcel in the PPDSD will derive therefrom; and be it further

TITLE: A Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of \$1,612,000 Bonds of the County of Chautauqua, New York, to Pay the Cost of the Portland Pomfret Dunkirk Sewer District Infiltration and Inflow Reduction Project

**BY:** Public Facilities and Audit & Control Committees:

**AT THE REQUEST OF:** County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr. and Legislature Chairman Pierre E. Chagnon:

WHEREAS, the Portland Pomfret Dunkirk Sewer District (District) was established by Resolution 272-77 in accordance with County Law Article 5-A; and

WHEREAS, a 2022 engineering study of the District's collection system identified numerous items in need of repair which, in their current state, are allowing for infiltration out of and inflow into the sewer collection system (I & I); and

WHEREAS, the engineering firm of Barton and Loguidice prepared a Map and Plan dated July 2022 which includes recommended work to reduce I & I; and

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the financing of this capital project, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, have been performed; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to provide for the financing and undertaking of the District improvements authorized pursuant to the Local Finance Law; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The design and construction of improvements to reduce I & I in the Portland Pomfret Dunkirk Sewer District's collection system, in and for the County of Chautauqua, New York, at a maximum estimated cost of \$1,612,000, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 2.</u> The plan for the financing of such improvements shall be by the issuance of up to \$1,612,000 bonds of said County herein authorized.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is thirty to forty years, pursuant to subdivision 4 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said County of Chautauqua, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. To the extent not paid from assessment and/or user charge water rates in the District, all the taxable real property in said County shall be subject to the levy of ad valorem taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same shall become due.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Director of Finance, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Director of Finance, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the Director of Finance, the chief fiscal officer of such County. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Director of Finance shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 7. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said County is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
  - 3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

<u>Section 8.</u> The County has previously indicated its official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

<u>Section 9.</u> This resolution, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in summary form in the official newspaper of such County, together with a notice of the Clerk of the County Legislature in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.

TITLE: Authorize County to Apply for Grants on Behalf of the Portland, Pomfret,

Dunkirk Sewer District for Inflow and Infiltration Repair

**AT THE REQUEST OF:** County Executive Paul M. Wendel, Jr. and Legislative Chairman Pierre E. Chagnon:

WHEREAS, Portland, Pomfret, Dunkirk Sewer District (PPDSD) infrastructure was initially installed in the 1930's, 1950's and 1980's and much of the infrastructure has not been updated or repaired since that time; and

WHEREAS, old infrastructure is likely to have cracks and leaks, which can lead to infiltration and inflow (I & I) of storm and ground water into, and leakage of sewage out of, collection system pipes; and

WHEREAS, sewage leaking out of pipes can result in an improper discharge of sewage to the ground, and such sewage can migrate to Lake Erie and surrounding areas; and

WHEREAS, storm and ground water entering into collection system pipes is unnecessarily processed through a treatment plant resulting in higher treatment cost; and

WHEREAS, I&I studies of the Portland, Pomfret, Dunkirk Sewer District collection system showed numerous areas in need of repair; and

WHEREAS, a Map and Plan has been developed for reduction of I & I (the Project); and

WHEREAS, the North County Industrial Water District No. 1 has a water storage tank which is in need of repair and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the financing of this capital project, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, have been performed; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to provide for the financing and undertaking of the District improvements authorized pursuant to the Local Finance Law; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Legislature of the County of Chautauqua, New York, as follows:

Section 1. To the extent not paid from assessment and/or user charge water rates in the District, all the taxable real property in said County shall be subject to the levy of ad valorem taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds as the same shall become due.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Director of Finance, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Director of Finance, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the Director of Finance, the chief fiscal officer of such County. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Director of Finance shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

- Section 7. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:
- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said County is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
  - 3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 8. The County has previously indicated its official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into this Tentative Agreement for an extension of the current CBA, subject to the terms below, with a new expiration date of December 31, 2023; and

THEREFORE, the parties agree to the following terms and conditions contained herein:

#### 1. Section 8.02 Wage Increases

• Effective January 1, 2023, the 2022 wage schedule (Appendix A) shall be increased by three percent (3%).

#### 2. One-time \$750.00 Bonus

- A one-time bonus of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) will be paid to all employees in accordance with the following terms and conditions:
  - o Employee must be a CSEA Unit 6300 member and County employee as of January 1, 2023. Employees hired after this date will not be eligible.

  - o The bonus will be paid on or before February 28, 2023 for eligible employees as defined above.

WHEREAS, Collaborative Children's Solutions is a not-for-profit organization that partners with service providers, agencies, organizations, and school districts throughout Chautauqua County to provide the necessary tools, resources and projects to help children reach their maximum potential; and

WHEREAS, Chautauqua County wishes to partner with Collaborative Children's Solutions by providing the organization with \$5,000 to bring motivational speaker Chris Herren to Chautauqua County to speak with children in our local school districts; and

WHEREAS, Since 2009, Chris Herren has spoken to over a million students, athletes and community members, sparking honest discussions on the topics of substance use disorder and wellness by sharing his story, which has helped renew the focus on prevention education and challenged audiences to rethink how we look at the disease of addiction; and

WHEREAS, On September 14 and September 15, 2022, Collaborative Children's Solutions will bring Chris Herren to speak with students in the Bemus Point, Brocton, Chautauqua Lake, Dunkirk, Falconer, Fredonia, Frewsburg, Sherman and Southwestern School Districts to share his story and then work with the system of care that Collaborative Children's Solutions is building around them to help guide students on their road to success; and

WHEREAS, Chautauqua County has received an award of \$1,021,617 in the first round of Opioid settlement funding; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Resolution No. 179-21, 79% of the County's final settlement proceeds may only be used for approved uses, which are defined to include the following categories: treating opioid use disorder; supporting people in treatment and recovery; connecting people who need help to help; addressing the needs of criminal-justice involved persons; addressing the needs of pregnant or parenting women and their families, including babies with neonatal abstinence syndrome; preventing over-prescribing and ensuring appropriate prescribing and dispensing of opioids: preventing misuse of opioids; and
